
FOUNTAIN PARK

Venice has the perfect place to stop and relax on Miami Avenue. At the corner of Ponce De Leon and Nokomis avenues stands an elegant cast iron fountain surrounded by shade trees. In 1986 the First National Bank of Venice donated a fountain which was replaced by then-mayor Merle Graser in 1995.

It is the perfect spot to sit on a bench and listen to the water cascade from the statue of Hebe, the goddess of youth. At night, watch the fountain pool lights change colors from blue to purple, red, white, and green.
