










Once used only in commercial installations, glass blocks have proven their versatility. During the Art Deco era (1920-30s), they began to appear in residential basements, mainly utilized as windows. Durable and water-repellent, glass blocks hit the height of popularity in the 1980s, when they were applied to create walls and shower doors in bathrooms. Today, the newly updated shapes and textures make them a trendy choice when upgrading or building a home. Many times, they are simply utilized as a design element to pull the light into darkened corners, but they may also be spotted on the side panels of front doors, in windows, and in skylights. Colored and frosted glass blocks are now available, making it even easier to find a stylish option for enhancing the design of a room. Glass blocks can be implemented almost anywhere for paramount beauty, privacy, and infused lighting.

Bathroom Artistry Accent Lighting



he right lighting can transform a bathroom into the ideal oasis for relaxation, while still retaining the functionality so crucial for

In the featured bathroom, accent lighting has been placed within the ceiling ledge, and above and below the cabinets, helping to bathe the room in soft inviting light. Giving the room depth and dimension, while adding a touch of drama and luxury, the bathroom becomes the perfect canvas for design features such as artwork, unique tiles, or plants. Layering the light sources within a room produces optimal results, providing ample brightness so that the space can be used with safety and ease.

While fluorescent bulbs were once en vogue, Light Emitting Diodes (LEDs) are now a more popular option for brightening homes. An advantage of LEDs is that they are more energy-efficient than fluorescent or incandescent bulbs, using as much as half the electricity of fluorescent bulbs and up to 80% less than standard sources. Also, studies have shown that while traditional lights emit more heat, causing the temperature within the home to elevate, LEDs use less energy and release less heat, helping your home to stay cooler. They also tend to last much longer, with some top-of-the-line types lasting more than 10 years. This kind of lighting is excellent around cabinet areas,

especially when illumination is needed for extended periods of time.

Offering additional brightness to the room are the frosted glass windows that stream natural light into the bathroom. The sleek glass shelving becomes a defined area for displaying apothecary items to their greatest advantage.
