



the state of Florida, this magical attraction begins in early spring and lasts through late summer with most of the sighting in the Everglades and in our nature preserves. More than 2,000 species with over 56 species can be found in Florida.

These critters are nocturnal, and if you are wondering where they spend most of their day, you will find them on the ground in the grassy, marshy areas and the sandy soil. They can also be found near the edge of lakes, ponds, and streams. Once the sun goes down, they are ready to spring into action, and the light show begins!

Interestingly, most fireflies are males and glow in the night to attract mates. The females are usually nestled in plants or flowers, and once they connect with a male, they respond with the same light pattern. Each species has a unique glow pattern that they use to communicate, some with a bluish-green light and others

may shine with an orange or yellow hue. These winged wonders can be seen usually between the hours of midnight and 3 a.m., and if it is raining, they will not glow at all.

Fireflies live approximately two months, just long enough to mate. Oddly, although the name firefly might give the idea that they are flies, they are actually winged beetles.



If you like to plan ahead, starting in mid-March and running for just a couple of weeks, Blue Spring State Park located in Orange City, just north of Orlando holds its annual Lights at Night event. There, you can enjoy a fairy-tale-like experience as their dark tropical forest becomes a magical place all lit up with enchanting fireflies.

One of nature's most charming gifts, fireflies continue to produce a sense of awe and delight for children and the young at heart as these winged wonders light up the night with their magical glow.
